# Office of the Chairperson Committee for Fixation & Regulation of Fee of Private Schools, J&K (FFRC)

Order No: 1 0 -FFRC (FF) of 2021 Dated: 15 -05-2021

Sub: Fixation and Regulation of fee of Central Valley Educational Society Panzan, Chadoora Budgam.

Central Valley Educational Society Panzan, Chadoora Budgam submitted file for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the School, which has been registered in FFRC office under No. FFRC/FF/2021/Bud/286.

The perusal of the school file revealed as under:

- a) The School Management is subjecting the children to screening test for granting admission in the school.
- b) It appears that a substantial amount is being taken out of school corpus in the shape of rent which father as Chairperson of the school is paying to his son (landlord).
- c) The audit report shows an amount of Rs 205,713.00 as excess of income over expenditure, but the said amount has been deducted from income of the school.

Subjecting a child to test for granting admission in the school does not stand to reason. The Right To Education Act 2009, which has been made applicable to UT of J&K, bars taking of screening test for granting admission in a school. If more students are seeking admission than the intake capacity of the school, in such eventuality children can be admitted to the school by draw of lots. The school management is accordingly restrained from subjecting children, who seek admission in the school to any screening test.

Hon'ble the Supreme Court has observed in plethora of judgments that education is charity. The Chairperson who is father of the landlord of the school building and premises shall have to satisfy whether it is legally permissible to charge and collect huge rent from the school corpus.

At the moment while regulating the fee structure of the school, which is being done for the first time, the rent charged and collected from the school corpus is not deemed to be part of school corpus, but income to the landlord. If the rent is to be taken to be part of school corpus at this stage, then the existing fee is to be reduced. However, as already stated the benefit of rent is given to the landlord at this stage. This issue will be considered again after opportunity of hearing is given to the landlord and the Chairperson of the school, and decision thereon will be taken thereafter. At this stage the amount of rent is not added to the school corpus for regulating the fee of the school, but is deemed to be entitlement of landlord subject to further orders.

The perusal of the Audit report as on 31 March 2020, statement of receipts and payments show that the school is having excess income of Rs 205,713.00 over expenditure, but this amount has been deducted from the gross income of the school.

The school management shall have to explain this position as well. However, this amount at this stage is subtracted from the gross income of the school for regulating the Fee Structure of the school.

The material, documents and the justification given by the School management for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the School was examined. On due consideration of the material produced by the School management and after considering all relevant factors which govern the subject, and the trend in income and expenditure incurred by the School, the Committee finds it just and proper to fix and regulate the fee structure of the School as under:

Non- compliance will attract penal action under law.
