Sub: Fixation and Regulation of fee of May Fair Higher Secondary School, 66 Chand Nagar, Near Khalsa College, Jammu.


May Fair Higher Secondary School, 66 Chand Nagar, Near Khalsa College, Jammu submitted file for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the School, which has been registered in FFRC office under No. **FFRC/FF/2019-21/Jmu/106**.

The **fee structure** of the School is being regulated by the Committee for the first time by this order.

Record shows that School Management has maintained same Tuition Fee from academic session 2018-19 to 2020-21, and has not collected Annual Fee for session 2020-21. In view of **Order No.45-FFRC of 2021 dated 18.02.2021**, the School Management has to maintain same Tuition Fee for academic session 2021-22.

The record also shows that School Management is charging and collecting Advertisement Fund as component of Annual Fee. Besides this, Electricity Charges is also made component of Annual Fee. Record also shows that an amount of Rs.360/- is charged and collected from students on account of Newspaper Fund. An amount of Rs.350/- is charged as Music and Dance Fund. The Chairman is being paid Rs.60,000/- per month as salary from School Corpus.

The Audit Report for the year ended 31.03.2020 shows that an amount of Rs.54,288/- has been spent on Advertisement and Rs.88,319/- are shown to have been expended on Annual Day Function. An amount of Rs.45,536/- have been paid as Electricity Charges.



The record shows that School is run by a Trust. Even otherwise, every Educational Institution has to be run on no profit basis. Some reasonable surplus, not beyond 15% has to be allowed to the School Management for being spent on welfare of students and for providing them quality education.

Education is not commerce. So huge amounts, derived from parents cannot be spent on Advertisements. Electricity Charges are not component of Annual Fee, being current expense, it is an element of Tuition Fee. The School is having surplus which is to be preserved.

The record produced and the justification given by the School Management for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the School was examined. The same was considered in accordance with norms set out in various judgements and fixed by statute. On due consideration of the entire conspectus of the school record and acknowledged parameters and settled norms for regulating the fee structure of the School, material produced by the School Management, income-expenses, income and expenditure of the School and after considering all other relevant factors which govern the subject, the Committee finds it just and proper to regulate the **fee structure** of the School as under:

The aforesaid exercise has been undertaken and fee structure regulated in a manner that excluded the commercialization and profiteering of education completely.

Charging and collecting of Admission Fee is prohibited by statutes. The School Management is prohibited from charging and collecting Admission Fee from the students.

The School management is directed not to charge any other fee from the students other than the fee approved by the Committee.



The School management is further directed not to make any future enhancement in fee structure under any head without permission of the Committee.

Realization of Annual Fee from the students shall be subject to providing the facilities to students and actual expenditure of the school on relevant overheads.

The School management shall display this approved fee structure on School notice board, upload it on School website and publish the same in local daily newspapers.

Non-compliance will attract penal action under law.


