Sub: Fixation and Regulation of Fee of Apex School of Secondary Education Mirgund, Budgam.

Apex School of Secondary Education Mirgund, Budgam submitted file for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the school, which has been registered in FFRC office under No. FFRC/FF/2021/Bud/543.

The fee structure of the school is being regulated by the committee for the first time by this order.

School record shows that school management has not charged and collected annual fee in academic session 2019-20.

One of the components of the annual fee is "Class Room Fund". This is an irrelevant and impermissible component and is deleted from annual fee. Another component is an unexplained "Misc Expenses" and same is also deleted from annual fee.

Record also shows that Chartered Accountant has dealt with a charitable institution, as a commercial entity and has audited the record accordingly. Chartered Accountant Shafiya Manzoor has prepared profit—loss account, probably being oblivion of Sec 10 of income tax Act 1961. The Chartered Accountant be asked to explain the position with one week by sending separate communication.

Record also shows that huge "Mess Expenses" are met out from student fee.

The record produced and the justification given by the School management for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the School was examined. The same was considered in accordance with norms set out in various judgments and prescribed by statute. On due consideration of the entire conspectus of the school record and acknowledged parameters and settled norms for regulating the fee structure of the school, material produced by the School management, income-expenses, income and expenditure, of the School and after considering all other relevant factors which govern the subject, the Committee finds it just and proper to regulate the fee structure of the School as under:

The school management shall maintain an account of school funds (fee etc) in a Schedule Bank, which shall be operated by a person(s) authorized by school management. Record about all the expenses/expenditures shall be maintained with receipts.

The school management is directed not to charge any other fee from the students other than the fee approved by the Committee.

The school management is further directed not to make any future enhancement in fee structure under any head without permission of the Committee.

Realization of Annual Fee from the students shall be subject to providing the facilities to students and actual expenditure of the school on

The School management shall display this approved fee structure on School notice board, upload it on School website and publish the same in local

Non-compliance will attract penal action under law.
