Sub: Fixation and Regulation of fee of KC Gurukul Public School Ploura jammu.

KC Gurukul Public School Ploura Jammu.Submitted its file registered under No.Edu/ FFRC/FF/2019-21/Jmu/134 in this office for fixation and regulation of fee structure of the School.

Earlier the fee structure of the school was regulated vide order No.12 –FFC of 2019 dated 10-05-2019 in terms of order No. 106 FFC of 2017 dated 20-10-2017. This was in view of that the school had not approached the Committee for regulation of fee structure.

The school management was not satisfied with the order and approached the then chairman FFC for reconsideration of the order by submitting supportive documents to justify their claim of reconsideration.

The case remained pending and in 2020. The school management again approached the Committee for reconsideration of the earlier order with fresh documents and justification.

The committee passed order No.52-FFRC (FF) dated 07-04-2021 regulating the fee structure of the school for session(s) 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24.

The School again filed review against order No. 52 FFRC (FF) of 2021 stating that the order has been issued without any change in fee structure, based on previous order No. 12 FFC of 2019.

The School submits;-

That injustice has been done to the school by reducing school fee @ 670/student. By the implementation of said order the school would face financial crisis as its receipts would reduce by Rs.48.20 lakhs per annum.in this scenario school would incur loss of Rs.13 lakh per annum.

that the Committee has also overlooked an important financial issue of repaying the loan liabilities of the school to the tune of Rs. 1.60 crores as reflected in the balance sheet.

that, the school has no reserve fund required to be maintained as per CBSE bylaws to run the school for three months in case of any exigency.

That the school has to return the unsecure loan to the tune of 1 cr,the school is unable to complete the no.of projects like Auditorium, Multipurpose Hall, Junior Computer lab and up gradation of swimming pool due to financial crunch."

On examination of the record submitted by the school following observations have been made;

1. The school was charging tuition fee in 2019-20 as under;

The Chairman of the School has given an undertaking on 28-06-2021 stating that, if the committee maintains the fee and annual charges charged by school in 2021-22, the school will not ask for enhancement of fee for the session(s) 2021-22 and 2022-23.

The school as per the record submitted has;

- 1. 35 class rooms
- 2. 01 Library
- 3. Separate Washrooms for boys and girls
- 4. 2 staff rooms
- 5. Physics, Biology and Chemistry labs. one each.
- 6. 01 courtyard
- 7. English language lab.
- 8. Skating ring
- 9. Swimming pool
- 10. Play ground
- 11. Computer lab.

The balance sheet of previous year (2021-22) shows that the school has generated 11% surplus with the fee school is presently charging.

On due consideration of the material produced by the School management, the financial aspects, observations reflected supra and after considering all relevant factors which govern the subject, the Committee finds it just and proper regularize the tuition fee of the school as was applicable in 2019-20 in order to maintain a reasonable surplus, so that the school management will be in a position to run the institution smoothly. The fee structure shall remain applicable for 2023-24.

In case of Annual fee the school is directed to charge annual fee as regulated vide order No. No.52-FFRC (FF) dated 07-04-2021as under;



The enhancement or otherwise for next session will be considered after the school submits audited financial statements of 2022-23.

The School management is directed not to charge any fee from the students other than the fee approved by the Committee.

The School management is further directed not to make any future enhancement in fee structure under any head without permission of the Committee or charge any fee under any head created after issuance of this order without seeking prior approval from the Committee.

Non- compliance will attract penal action under Law.

(The school management shall display this approved fee structure on the school notice Board and upload the same on school website. The management shall also publish the approved fee structure in a leading daily news paper.)
