Circular

Sub:- Charging of Admission Fee by Private Schools in Violation of FFRC Guidelines.

It has come to the notice of the Fee Fixation and Regulation Committee (FFRC), Jammu and Kashmir, that certain private schools are charging admission fee in violation of the guidelines already issued by the FFRC Vide Circular no:- 01 FFRC of 2023, dated:- 20/12/23 & Government Order no: 228-Edu of 2020, dated:- 18/09/2020 on the subject.

In this regard, all private schools and stakeholders are hereby directed to strictly adhere to the guidelines laid down by the FFRC, J&K (UT) regarding the charging of admission fee.

Any Violation of these guidelines will be dealt with in accordance with the rules and regulations governing private Educational Institutions. All private educational institutions are instructed to display the approved fee structure prominently on their premises and website for the information of parents and guardians. The parents are directed to deposit the fee only after the fee fixed by this Committee is displayed on the notice board. In case any excess fee is demanded by the school, the matter must be promptly reported to the undersigned.

Parents are also requested to cooperate with the Committee in curbing the menace of the admission fee. It is ultimately in the interest of parents to do so and cooperate with the Committee in this behalf.

Failure to comply with these instructions by private schools will attract appropriate action as per law including penalties and possible withdrawal of the school recognition by the competent authority. It has also come to the notice that no receipts are issued by the Private Schools who are demanding admission fee. The parents from whom the fee has been demanded shall inform the undersigned and in that case the matter will be referred to the investigation agency to examine the complaint by checking the records of the schools. The Private Schools demanding admission fee should take note of this and abstain from charging any admission fee.
