CIRCULAR

No.: FFRC/JK-Jmu/Circular/2026/10-18

Subject: Constitution of Parents Association in Private Schools under Rule-7 of the J&K School Education (Fixation and Regulation of Fee) Rules.

Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir School Education Rules of 2010 framed thereunder provide a structured mechanism for ensuring transparency and accountability in private schools;

Whereas, **Rule-7** of the J&K School Education Rule of 2010 mandates the constitution of a *Parents Association* in every private school in a prescribed manner;

Whereas, it has come to the notice of the Fee Fixation and Regulation Committee (FFRC), J&K, that certain individuals, groups, unions, or federations claiming to represent parents are functioning outside the statutory framework;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Committee, the following is hereby ordered for strict compliance:

1. Every private school in Jammu & Kashmir shall mandatorily constitute a *Parents Association* strictly in accordance with the provisions of **Rule-7**. The composition, election/selection process, tenure, and functioning shall be as prescribed under the said rules.
2. The Parents Association shall be confined to the respective school only, and shall consist exclusively of parents or guardians of students currently enrolled in that school.
3. Any individual, association, group, federation, or collective body of parents formed outside the framework of **Rule-7**, and not constituted at the individual school level, shall be treated as unauthorized and having no legal validity. Such bodies shall not be recognized by any school or authority in matters pertaining to fee regulation or school administration.
4. The duly constituted Parents Association shall act as a formal and recognized platform for interaction between school management and parents, particularly in matters relating to fee fixation, grievances, and other academic or administrative concerns, as provided under law.

5. All private school managements are directed to:

- a) Ensure immediate constitution or reconstitution of the Parents Association, and submit the same to this office without any delay;
 - b) Maintain proper records of its formation and proceedings;
 - c) Extend full cooperation to the functioning of the association as per rules.
6. Parents/guardians are advised to associate only with the duly constituted Parents Association of their respective school and refrain from engaging with any unauthorized external body.
7. Any deviation from the above directions shall be viewed seriously and may invite action under the provisions of the J&K School Education rules of 2010 framed thereunder.

It has come to the notice of the Committee that certain individuals are falsely claiming to represent Parents Associations, in violation of the statutory provisions in force. Such actions are unlawful and contrary to the prescribed Rules. All such individuals are hereby warned that any continued violation shall be construed as a breach of the applicable Rules, and appropriate action under law shall be initiated against them without further notice. The general public, particularly parents, are advised not to encourage or associate with such unauthorized and unscrupulous elements, who are attempting to exploit parents for their personal interests.

It is further informed that a complaint has already been referred to the appropriate investigating agency for necessary action under law.

This circular shall come into force with immediate effect.
